Camp Rules

- 1) Historical demonstrations must be done only with materials and items that would have existed in the time period that you are portraying.
- 2) Please keep all modern camping gear covered such as coolers, plastic tarps, lighters, etc. and anything else that did not exist in the time period you are portraying
- 3) Campfires must stay inside properly dug fire pits and the flames must be kept to a minimum. All campfire pits must be refilled before you leave.
- 4) Quiet time begins at 10 p.m.
- 5) Pets must be on a leash at all times
- 6) All campers and traders are responsible for the clean-up of their campsite.
- 7) Children must be supervised at all times.
- 8) No vehicles will be allowed in primitive camp areas from Saturday at 7 a.m. to Sunday at 4 p.m., unless approved by a member of CRR .
- 9) All food Vendors must pre-register with and be approved by the CRR prior to the schedule event days
- 10) We reserve the right to limit the number of food and marquis vendors
- 11) We are a family friendly event.
